The **Montessori Academy of Lancaster** invites your children to spend their summer traveling around the world with us!

Summer Camp 2008 will be a summer to remember as your children have the opportunity to experience different facets of the Earth, including the environment, countries, cultures and people that make it so special.

Our new camp program is designed so that each week builds on the "world theme", yet every week is individual enough to stand on its own. This system will work as well for children that will be spending the summer with us, as it will for the children that can only join us for a week or so.

Theme Camps 3 to 5 yrs. 9am- 12 pm

1. **Week 1- June 2-6- "Green" week**- Our "green" theme will center on the earth and how important it is to us. It will include reducing, reusing, and recycling activities, as well as planting and caring for a garden.
2. **Week 2- June 9-13- Photography**- The children will use disposable and digital cameras, take photos, make passports for their future journeys, and work with a local professional photographer.
3. **Week 3- June 16-20- Games**- This week our campers will learn and play games that are played around the world, and will use their creativity and some interesting materials to generate their own game!
4. **Week 4- June 23-27- Language and Culture**- French, Indian, Korean, Spanish, Vietnamese! Each day of this camp will have a special guest teaching a new language and culture.
5. **Week 5- July 7-11- Creative Dramatics**- Drama, stories, and folktales from around the world will be the focus of fun this week! Where did that folktale originate? Find out at this camp filled with dress-up, imagination, and more drama than you can save for your mama!
6. **Week 6- July 14-18- Sports**- Sports played in Africa, North America, Europe, Asia, and South America will be what the children will be learning about and playing at this fun-filled energetic camp!
7. **Week 7- July 21-25- Cooking**- Clean, cut, measure, bake, boil, grill; all terms your little chef will become familiar with! Yum! This special camp will include cooking and lots of sampling of foods from around the world. **Caution: this week would not be a good choice for children with food allergies.**
8. **Week 8- July 28- August 1- Music and Instruments**- What do castanets, cymbals, xylophones, kettledrums, tambourines, organs, clarinets, French Horns, zithers, oboes, guitars, and pianos have in common?? We will be learning about them and the families (string, wind, percussion) from which they come, in a musical adventure around the world!
9. **Week 9- August 4-8- Art**- Five days will be barely enough time to dabble and sample different medium, and be exposed to all of the wonderful works of art that exist in our world. Your little Picasso is also going to have a chance to work with a local artist.
10. **Week 10- August 11-15- Around the World**- Get your suitcase and passport ready! Your child will become a world traveler and visit a different Country each day of the week. Campers will learn about food, culture, dress and daily life of the native people.

Example#1: 8DC would mean you are signing your 3-5 year old up for Week 8, 9am-12pm and 12-3pm.
Example #2: 14DC would mean you are signing your 6-8 year old up for Week 4, 9am-12pm and 12-3pm.

Campers will enjoy organized games, crafts and snacks with camp counselors. Part of the fun will involve water games and expand on theme camp ideas. **\$95/wk. Please bring a towel, sunscreen, and a swimsuit.**
