The Montessori Academy of Lancaster invites your children to spend their summer **Exploring our World!**

Summer Camp 2011 will be a summer to remember as your children have the opportunity to experience different facets of our world, which includes but is not limited to: science, the arts, and friendships!

Our camp program is designed so that each week evolves with “exploring our world”, yet every week is individual enough to stand on its own. This system will work as well for children who will be spending the summer with us, as it will for the children who only join us for a week or so.

Theme Camps 3 to 5 yrs. 9am– 12 pm

Exploring our World...

1. **Week 1– June 6-10 - ...Sports and Games**– Sports of all types will be put together to make a workout “fit” for the youngest developing athletes.
2. **Week 2– June 13-17 - ...Art**– Five days will be barely enough time for your little artist to dabble and sample different medium, and create a gallery of all their fabulous work!
3. **Week 3– June 20-24- ...Science**– What hypothesis will they come up with? What results will they find? Science is so exciting...let’s see what our campers discover together...
4. **Week 4– June 27-July 1– ...Garden to Table**– Clean, cut, measure, bake, boil, grill; all terms your little chef will become familiar with! Yum! **Caution: this week would not be a good choice for children with food allergies.**
5. **Week 5– July 11-15– ...Drama**– Drama, stories, and folktales will spark the children’s imagination as they work to create their very own production. This camp is filled with dress-up, imagination, and more drama than you can save for your mama!
6. **Week 6- July 18-22-...Space**– The moon, stars and the planets...so much to explore. Your astronaut will be an expert at the end of this week out of this world!
7. **Week 7– July 25-29 ... Music**- Your little musician will not leave town on a tour bus, but they will learn how to play several instruments and create their own music in their first band.
8. **Week 8– August 1-5– ...Oceans**– Covering almost 71% of our earth, our oceans are filled with so many species five days won’t be long enough to have the sea adventure of a lifetime.
9. **Week 9– August 8-12– ...Creepy Crawlies and Busy Bugs**– Some can be icky and some can be neat, but all bugs have an important place in our ecosystem! Campers will learn about different types of bugs, what they eat, where they live and why we need them. Lots of nature hikes will be a part of this week.
10. **Week 10– August 15-19– ...Camp Around the World**– Pack your duffle bag and get your passport ready! Your child will become a world traveler and camp in a different Country each day of the week. Campers will learn about food, culture, dress and daily life of the native people.

Example #1: 8DC would mean you are signing your 3-5 year old up for Week 8, 9am-12pm and 12-3pm.
Example #2: 14DC would mean you are signing your 6-9 year old up for Week 4, 9am-12pm and 12-3pm.
